Wonderful promise here, they shall be filled. God's promises are true. God will fulfil the desires of those that he's called by grace.

And oh, we often feel to lack the grace that we need to help us to continue. To being able to bear witness of what the Lord has revealed to us in our pathway.

We are tempted sometimes to give it all up. That's when the enemy comes in. We've made very conscious of the enemy of our souls.

And all these hindrances in coming to the mercy seat. Because we want real things, as we think, in this world, that we see with a natural eye.

[1:22] But far be it. It is the eye of faith. The eye of the soul. The soul that has these sincere desires.

To seek after Jesus' love. It's not natural. It's far from being natural. It is the spiritual mind, quickened by his grace.

That brings you to know some of these blessings. That will truly enrich your soul and mind. Jesus speaks. And speaks to thee.

Say, poor sinner. Lovest thou me? More than these. We're in the world. We're part of it. But oh Lord, those things that draw you and me aside.

Those are the flesh. That looks after fleshly, excitable things. Which the devil will very much try to allure you and draw you aside.

[2:26] Nothing like the alluring of Jesus. I will allure you and bring you into the wilderness. What a mercy if he's made the world to you and me at times.

It won't be all the times, especially in early days in our lives. We are attracted by the natural eye to natural things.

There are those necessities of life that we look upon. And we know that they are necessary in the sight of God. But they're not, dear friends, to overshadow the things that are most needful for the welfare of your soul and mine.

And so we bless God for the record in his word of the great multitudes that were gathered to them.

And he didn't preach them material things. He preached them unto them himself. And God the Father.

[3:31] That we might be called the children of God. And we are pressing toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

Once we have been called and quickened by his grace. It's a great mystery. But God is formed in your heart the hope of glory.

The object of your soul's desires and mine. To have a hunger and thirst after righteousness. We do have to pray for the Lord to keep us from that self-righteousness and pride.

And not be left to be a Pharisee. But we're exhorted that we need to exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees.

That we shall at last enter into the kingdom of God. Kingdom of heaven. The kingdom of God suffereth violence. And the violent take it by force.

[4:37] And we look to him to grant us a spiritual mind. We know it's a carnal mind. And intermingled with the carnal mind are spiritual things.

And they're very precious when the Lord applies them. And we need that they lead us to Christ. Lead us to Christ. Lead and guide me into the truth.

And Lord, just don't lead me to it. But make it attractive to me. Make it powerful in the influence of my walk and my conduct.

That I'm following on to know thee. You see, we need to, he said, be perfect like I am perfect. But it's complete.

That word perfect means you're complete in him. Your favor to know that righteousness covers all your sins.

[5:41] The robe of righteousness. And it's not being, come not nigh me, I am holy than thou. That's the Pharisees' religion. But the righteousness of Christ imputed by the Spirit.

And we bless the Lord for his truth. That we want to feel the effects more of it. And that we might dwell more upon these blessedness.

That we come through the truth of the gospel. And to be made wise unto salvation. Through the merits of Jesus. And there's no other way.

Lead me to Calvary. Lead me in the paths of righteousness. For his name's sake. And grant, O Lord, that I might be kept by the power of God.

In that narrow way. And to be following in the footsteps of Christ. And you may say, well, that's a hard thing to do. Is it? If you'll be born again.

You'll walk in the fear of the Lord. You'll look to have that grace. I know there's two opposites in us. The calm mind we'll ever carry to our death.

Is enmity to God. But the spiritual mind will give life and peace. On occasions when the Lord favors you. To be nourished and fed.

To know those living waters. And have water from the wells of salvation. To satiate your soul and mine. With those moments of truth.

That are applied. That he tells you. Yea, I've loved thee well, my child. And he constrains you by the love of Christ. To follow him. In the footsteps of the flock of God.

This is the way. Walk in it. When you turn to the right. Or to the left. And there'll be that purification. In your heart and mind.

[7:38] When Jesus. Is in the. Uppermost. Place in your feelings. And in your souls. We have to confess. We're not always there.

But are those sweet moments. When we're brought before the cross. To consider him. That endured such contradiction. Of sin as himself. Lest we be faint.

And wear it in the mind. And you will know very much. Being wearied in the minds. You seem to. Long. And pant.

After the living water brooks. That he might draw water. For you. And me. To water ourselves. And it might be as a. Well watered garden.

In his likeness. Oh what a blessed. Gift is the. Gift of salvation. All of his free and sovereign grace. Oh what a mercy.

If you're hungry. And thirsting. Remember here. The Lord was preaching. To this multitude. And though we don't have such multitudes.

In our day. Only. In those places. Dear friends. Where it's all of the flesh. Gloring in the flesh. But we must not glory in the flesh.

[10:26] God forbid that I should glory. Say in the cross of Christ. My. Lord. By whom the world is crucified. I don't know. There's a crucifixion. You know. Of the things of this world.

We have to learn. To hold them with a loose hand. And. Seeking first. The kingdom of God. And his righteousness. And all these other things.

Shall be added unto you. You can't buy yourself. In that way. Into heaven. Can you. What a mercy that is. So. It's for poor and needy sinners.

Seeking water. And there is no. The tongue. Faith. And the thirst. I. The Lord. Will hear them. Oh how we have to be brought. Minished. And brought love. With tribulatory. Pathways.

To walk in. But I am the Lord. And so he says. I am the Lord. I fail not. He fails not.

And good hope for a grace. That. He is my saviour. That he has eternally loved me. And if by the grace of God.

Your names are recorded in the book of life. He will not leave you forever. For that be set time. To favour your soul. With the pardon. And with the assurance.

[20 : 49] That you are. On your way to heaven. He made it secure. And all your blessing for it. He satisfied.

That aching void. That the world could not fill. By giving you. Spiritual blessings. In heavenly places. In Christ Jesus. And you have gone on your way rejoicing.

You have been filled. Your cup run over. I think I mentioned this morning. And so it is. You have gone your way rejoicing. He has changed my heart.

Renewed my will. Returned my feet. Designed. It must be so in your life. Some real evidence. It is not being satisfied. Because you have attended.

The house of God all your life. That was not satisfaction. It is what the Lord has spoken to you. My sheep hear my voice. Oh be very careful. Whether you are grabbing at straws.

[21:48] Straws won't save you. It's what the Lord has revealed. What he's applied with power to yourself. You know you are hastening to hell.

If you have nothing. To be unable to speak of them. Lord granted you the acceptance of hearing the gospel. You're not satisfied. You've not got a full hunger or thirst as yet.

But you know this. That he is the one thing needful to sinners. And he speaks. As I just said. My sheep hear my voice. And I know them.

Has he known you? Has he given you this appetite for the gospel? Has he unlocked the door of your heart? And come in and supped with you.

And me with him. All that union and communion. With him from off the mercies. Other refuge have I known. Hangs my helpless soul alone.

[22:45] Leave me not alone. Stay calm and comfort my troubled hearts. Bless God if you've got a troubled heart. For the gospel.

Time will come when he will break through the gloom. When he bring your soul out of prison. And your praise. Loose him and let him go. Oh what a mercy to be loosed.

Loosen from the bonds dear friends. And sin and death. Righteousness. Righteousness. Will exalt Christ in your walk.

And your conduct and mine. But oh we seem to become so sure. Your poor tried child of God. They shall be filled.

And we will dwell a little on that. That you will be filled. Joy and peace. You'll die in peace if you're one of his.

Blessed Jesus. Formed in your heart and mind. The hope of glory. Oh what a refuge then. For sinners. The gospel makes known.
