That thinks. That he has been redeemed. Thinks he's had a promise. Thinks he's had a fear not. But you see. He's going to keep you and me.

[34:25] Humble in the dust. If so be. There might be hope. There might be hope. Of your soul being redeemed. Because it is because of your iniquities.

Your transgressions. That you are afflicted. We read that many are afflictions of the righteous. But the Lord. Delivering them out of them all. For.

What a privilege dear friends. To be conveyed into heaven at last. In spite of your sins. That blotted out. To plunge in you beneath that pattern.

Of his sin of unenclined. And. This is what faith believes in. The substance of things hoped for. The evidence of things not seen. That.

Soul trouble. Draught into that fear. That God has condemned you. Because you're under a broken law. And when he says.

There's no condemnation of them. That are not under the law. That are not under sin. But who by the grace of God. Have been taught. To number their days.

[37:21] And to look to the Lord Jesus. For salvation. How shall we escape. If we neglect it. What a refuge then. For your soul and mine.

And you'll have cause to praise him. Whose wonderful works of the children and men. So what a mercy to be. More concerned. And more exercised.

In spite of your providential needs. Which we shall need till the dying day. To realize that God knows. And God will be inquired of. By the house of Israel.

To do these things for them. And we do need to know. That we're chosen vessels. Don't we? That have been eternally loved. And will therefore be that.

Good testimony given to you and me. That food mercy. That. That. As you do business in great waters. You see the works of the Lord.

[38:24] The wonders in the deep. A blessing for it. That. He has taught you to cry. Into him. So the righteous cry.

For the imputed righteousness of Christ. To cover all your. All your. Problems. All your difficulties. All your iniquities. All your iniquities. Were.

A pledge. May I have loved it. Will never last in love. Yes. You will reel to and fro. And believe in the depths of your soul's trouble.

You will know what it is. To reel to and fro. Like the drunken man. Be at your wits end. And then you cry. You see. The true believer.

The true believer. Will be burdened. Must know how the case stands. How it will be with him. In the swanings of Jordan. Dread moment. The true mercy.

[39:23] The true mercy. You get the victory. Through the merits of Jesus. He saved it. Not man. It's not the priest who can save you.

You might go and confess him. And then confess with what's different. And that's a delusion. God sends them. A strong delusion. That they believe a lie. And that's why the very few.

That believe the bible. And the whole councils of God in it. But through the mercy of God. Your eyes have been opened. I believe. And your eyes will further be opened. To know the truth. And the truth shall make you free then. Of that condemnation. What a mercy.

And you'll know what that wrestling prayer is that we sang of. Because wonders do bring relief in deepest strength. You see. It won't be a smooth path. There'll be something to try you.

This will be a sobering thought upon you if Jesus is revealed to you as the object of your soul's desire. Jesus crucify me. The thought of crucifying Jesus with your sins, your sins nailed to the cross.

[45:19] Then they cry. Oh, what a mercy. If you can record those moments when the Lord has made you to cry. Few words, Lord help me.

May the Lord am oppressed. Don't take for me. And that oppression might come in through providential dealings with God with you.

And you may get to tremble and very much afraid. The Lord will cast, he said, I need I care. It is enough that I am not. Oh Lord, I need supply. Oh Lord, I burn bare.

I need to be able to pray. Or to be unable to believe in the Lord. For whosoever believeth in him shall not perish, but shall have everlasting life.

He saved them. And he will save you out of your distresses. He is in these very stages of this text of his what is revealed in this very psalm of 107.

[46:26] And so he will bring you through. Make the storm of time. You see, we need to come down and realize that all our times are in his hand.

And faith, dear friends, will believe that. And faith will be tried about it. But faith will be inquiring of God that I might know my times.

Times to tempt his power to prove. Times to taste. To save his love all for his covenant. And last and end, as shall please, our heavenly friend.

See, we must know this and be persuaded of this, of our times. And so when you get down, and by saying the dumps, I wonder if I've ever expressed you.

When you're cast down and all these things seem as great man came before you. And you seem to be in the valley of the shadow of death upon everything you touch. This is the time when you apply.

[47:35] This is the time when your faith will be like the exercise and you say, Lord, help me. Lord, undertake for me. As I sow into you.

And do, Lord, fulfill the scripture and deliver me. And confirm my soul that there is a favor to warn me. And that favor will yet find a deliverance.

Because when thou have no deliverance see. Yet still, this man I peace shall be. That peace of God, the past of God knowledge of understanding. My peace I leave with you.

He waits to take it and seal it. We've removed you from your fear of man and bringing us near. Well, we seem to bring fears upon us.

We fear that we're creatures of fear and breaking on where fear no fear is. But you will come back to our times.

[48:36] He's going to bring you into a sorrowful state. But you'll cry unto him. And you'll pray, oh God, do bow down on here.

For I am poor and needy. And do tell me that thou hast thoughts of peace towards me. And not of evil. To encourage me to wait upon the Lord.

To renew thy strength. Mount up with wings of eagles. Run and not be weary. Walk and not faint. We're ready to faint when these troubles come upon us.

We soon lose sight, don't we? When we listen to Satan and all his subtle devices. But to be brought there to really seek the Lord while he may be found.

Call you upon him near. Mount talk upon his name while he is near. And he's omnipresent. He's ever ready to ever bow down his ear to hear you.

[49:35] And he waits to be gracious. Because it's his sovereign right to wait to be gracious. When he tarries off till men are faint and comes at evening late. And he's not the same.

And he's not the same. And he's never been nor forsaken those. But he's begun this exercise of prayer. Or may you not be left to give up praying. You might get negative answers and no answers at all.
