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[0:00] The words I would venture to try and make a few remarks from, you will find in the 33rd chapter of the book of Exodus, verses 14 and 15, 14th and 15th verses.

Now the 33rd chapter of the book of Exodus, and he said, My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest.

And he said unto him, If thy presence go not with me, carry us, nor repent.

[1:34] In the first place, how that God had made him a leader, though he felt unfitted for it, though he could point when a man feels unfitted.

He saw how that God delivered and could deliver by his terrible acts.

And he beheld how the children of Israel were brought out by a mighty and outstretched arm.

He saw also the great deliverance at the Red Sea.

[3:07] When the enemies were driving behind, the wind see before them.

They do it, could not turn to the right hand or land. Yet God bid them to go forward. This and many other things he beheld.

He beheld also the time when they came. Notice the historical part of God's word I'm speaking here. It's the experience of God's people.

They came to the waters of Mara. Bitter waters.

Have you been brought to the waters of Mara? And sees God's wonders wrought. Or into those places one has already mentioned.

[4:21] Seen the enemy cast out before you. And brought forth out of nature's darkness. Into his marvelous land.

By a mighty and outstretched arm. And see his wonders wrought. In your own experience.

When you felt well I overthrown. But having come to the waters of Mara.

The troubles, trials and afflictions that may be in your path. You may have said at the time I can't partake of this.

That the waters are bitter. But you know. It is in these places that we prove.

[5:36] That Christ. The tree of life. And he's been cast into all the bitter waters of trial.

Difficulties and sorrows. He has enabled us to partake of them. And hath taught us.

That it is he and he only that can sweeten. Every bitter cough. And he does it.

By entering into the heart. Overthrowing. All the unbelief.

And all the fear that arrives. And gives us. And gives us all a taste. Of himself the living water.

[6:52] Which is sweet. Out of the taste. Here it is a time when joy. Filled for heart.

And we are unable to say. That the way he hath brought us.

And we're right. Well Moses experienced all these secrets from me. And I believe saw in them.

Also. Are those things which.

Are applicable. Are to. The leading and teaching. Of the spirit. To the soul. For. For.

[7:51] For. For. For. We believe. That all God's word. Is built. Is by. Inspiration. And that.

In the old. Testament. There is embodied. All the blessedness. Of the gospel.

That came through. The Lord. And Savior. Jesus Christ. Be not deceived.

Son of. For any of those things. May be spoken in thine ear. By false prophets. By deviser. To.

To. Turn aside. The old testament. Say. We have no need of it. Because.

I'm often trying to. Think of. That particular time. When this force. Was brought forth. As to his presence.

Being. With me then. Well. It must have been so. Because you know.

We believe. In the eternal decrees. And settlements of God. They were from. All eternity.

And that our lives. Minutest. Circumstance. Is subject.

[15:13] To his own. So that our birth. His presence. Is with us.

My presence. Then shall go with thee. In our childhood. And in our being.

For his presence. And his care over us. Is preserving care.

We shall not be here. In the platform of time. Bear with me here.

On these particular points. We look back upon life's journey. He saved this poor sinner.

[16:18] Through his presence. A watery drain. He had a lot of moment space.

To spare. I want to be no more. Is there not a cause?

You know. When we behold these things. It gives us. That. Confidence. Not a false confidence.

Confidence. It gives us that confidence. That though the enemy. Comes with many.

A piercing doubt. Comes off times to. Cause unbelief. To sow to work.

[17:20] That we wonder. That we wonder. If we know anything safely. The voices he cannot take from us.

Though often have tried. The Lord. The Lord. The Lord. The Lord. The Lord. The Lord. Will provide. To provide us with his presence.

His presence then. He says. It shall go with thee. No penitent about it.

It overthrows all the powers. Of everything else. It overthrows the power of Satan. It shall.

Against all the craft and deceit of an enemy. Who loves to calm by weakest mark in your destitution.

I'll tell you I believe God's purpose to permit us to come into a place of destitution.

To wean us away from self. For I've lived long enough to know that self is our worst enemy.

who cause you more mourning. That many hate who mourn over self.

[21:13] For self will often we plow against God's dealings with you.

So I don't deserve this. I've tried to live a better life. I've tried to do this than the other.

I go to chapel as often to author open. And some are left to say how many things I am doing for Christ.

But my friends has there been a little Pharisee pride mixed with it. Has there been some seeking our applause for whatever it might be as God in days of old chastised his people serving with you and I with us into destitution.

What are we going to do then? With all our gritted self-righteousness what we've done for Christ. and all our enthusiasm all those things that might be in our hearts that leave a short son that we ask into a place I say again of destitution.

[23:07] and we do not realize through all this season his with us his presence.

His ultimate end to bring us into a place of true confession. confession. It's right to commit you in confession.

Wearily speaking if I may speak for my soul my lips said many things in confession. My friends it's only just recently on one or two occasions I believe I've only I've known what real confession is.

it's coming like a dear woman to his feet. It won't be brought to his feet easy.

There would be the elm center, place of rest, where there were twelve wells in water, trees scored and ten palm trees, those wells of water to quench the forest, and the trees to shake them, from the hot sun of the desert, place of rest.

And also we might be full when he brings his children, his people to a place of rest.

rest. As in the twenty-third song, he made me to lie down in green parts.

[34:59] He leaded me beside the still waters, his presence. rest. It's such that he being that good shepherd, he's up over the sheep, our favorite lie down.

Now, these green pastures are various. sometimes an affliction can be a green pasture. When we are failing to lie down in that green pasture of affliction, and in that affliction of the clear waters, of his heavenly love, and peace, and joy within, afflictions may not see.

What else would escape our sight? How they fire, and devour we, and God, how pure, and bright, we pass through the still waters, where we may have passed through the tempest of the seas, of affliction and trial.

Yet, he brings us into the still waters, whispers, peace, be still, though we may still be in the trouble.

But he brought a calm in the soul, enabled us to be able to say, blessed future, and have brought me more away from the world, more away from my trifling toys, more away from my earthly pleasures, more away from my rigid idols, and I may have within me whole more of it.

[37:50] I bid thee all depart. I love those easy minds thoughts, jar the still waters of peace and joy that the world can never give.

hence then all those things that may be of a country or that may be appear to be to me a comfort when in themselves they are detestable to the pure all searching eye of God.

So I might swear it doesn't leave as many earthly pleasures. Well, God won't leave many of them. No misunderstanding us and here we prize the those things that has given us that we are likely to use for our confidence.

But I am speaking here of those things we may commit to be brought into the home anywhere else that are not according to this secret from him.

Our idols however they may be polished and we might have them in our home where at one time we would have not have thought of going to search for them no you can't shut them away from God you know God sees all things in your shoes and I don't want to want them how then he said to Moses and he said to Moses my presence shall go with thee and I will give thee perhaps for others could hold either or any to this name amen and or Thank you.
