- [ 0 : 00 ] I wouldn't speak. I'd be enabled by the Lord from a word found in the 20th Psalm. Psalm 20. And words that are in the fifth verse. We will rejoice in thy salvation. In the name of our God, we will set up our banners. The Lord fulfilled all thy petitions. This psalm is regarded as one of the messianic psalms. And that is to say, it is a psalm primarily concerned with the Lord Jesus Christ.
- [ 1 : 16 ] The promises that surrounded his appearing. And the performances that he would perform on behalf of his people. And therefore, primarily tonight, we shall deal with this word. With that aspect in our minds. Because we may well see in a moment. How the truth of God falls into perfect harmony. When we view it as a word that is in reference to the glorious person of Jesus Christ. There is another aspect which we shall try to examine a little tonight.
- [ 2 : 26 ] And that is, as so often is the case in the word of God. The Lord's people are brought in. When their petitions are recognized. And the consequences of their petitions are brought to light. But first of all, let us consider this word that I have read as a text. As being the glorious testimony of the Trinity. And being a testimony that is exclusively in connection with the Lord Jesus Christ. And his mighty works of salvation. Now you can see in a moment, perhaps. How this fits in.
- [ 3 : 33 ] And how this harmonizes this word before us. I've often read this text. And wondered what the psalmist could have meant. When he first says, We will rejoice in thy salvation. Thinking of it in this connection. That he was expressing the desires and the rejoicings of the people of God. Then when he comes to the end of the text. He says, The Lord fulfill all thy petitions. And I wondered who the psalmist was referring to. When he speaks this word. But if we look at it. As I think it is right to do so. As the testimony of God.
- [ 4 : 39 ] Concerning his dear son. The Lord Jesus Christ. We see how all these precious truths fall into relationship. One with another. And I want to take these three points. First of all, therefore, tonight. We will rejoice in thy salvation. Of course, God's people will rejoice in the salvation of God. It's a wonderful mercy to be brought.

To rejoice in the salvation of the Lord. But the great thing is this. That God will rejoice in the work of salvation.

Performed by his own dear son. He said, When the Lord Jesus appears. He said, This is my beloved son in whom I am well pleased.

[ 5 : 48 ] And the Lord Jesus himself tells us. That truth that we have in the 15th chapter of Luke.

That there is joy and rejoicing in. Among the angels of God. Over one sinner that is brought to repentance.

It's an important truth. It's an important truth. And a very precious truth. To realize that God the Father rejoices.

In the works of salvation. That is performed by his own dear son. And every one that comes under those works of salvation.

And are brought into the knowledge and experience of it in their own souls. They come under the rejoicing of God the Father.

[ 6 : 49 ] How glorious in the eyes of the dear Father. In the works of the dear Redeemer appear.

He looked upon him. His own dear son with great delight. All that he accomplished.

Was pleasing in the sight of God. And God the Father calls attention of sinners.

To that dear person. The Lord the Redeemer. And to the works that he undertook. In that passage that we were reading just now.

Behold my servant. Mine elect in whom of my servants. Soul divided. And all through that wonderful chapter.

[ 7 : 56 ] God is drawing attention. To the character. The person. And the doing.

And the working out of our salvation. By the dear Lord Jesus Christ. And he goes on to speak of him.

As the servant of the Lord. He who is in the world. When he comes into the world. He does not come into the world.

To judge the world. But to save. And he speaks of him in this way. Who is blind as my servant.

And deaf as the messenger. And deaf as the messenger that I sent. Because the Lord Jesus Christ. Had come.

[ 8 : 54 ] To completely fulfill all the requirements of God. God. And. And. Not to set up a judgment seat. But to work out the salvation.

Of every believer. The whole elect family of God. God. And. He says there. He will. Honor the Lord.

He will. Fulfill the Lord. Magnify the Lord. And. Make it. Honorable. That was the great purpose of Jesus.

In his coming. In his life. And all the glories of that Redeemer's. Life. Here on earth. Among men. Amen. I think we shall find a great deal of personal profit and encouragement.

If the Lord leads us in our meditation. To dwell much upon the person of the Lord Jesus. And especially on that aspect of his.

[ 10 : 01 ] Of his life. And. Person. When he was here on this earth. As the God man. The one who.

As it was said in that scripture. A bruised reed. He will not break. Oh. The tenderness of the heart of the dear Redeemer. And a smoking flax.

He will not quench. Indicating that the least measure that there is of life. And the slightest degree of the works of God's grace.

That there. The Lord. That there. Possibly would be discontented. By a great multitude of men. Are known and recognized by him.

Because his heart is full of tenderness. And his bowels. And his bowels melt with love. And God the Father.

[ 11 : 11 ] Beholding this. Prophetically in the psalm. And wondrously in the fulfillment of time. He says.

We will rejoice. In thy salvation. So God then the Father. Is well pleased.

With what his dear son. Doth perform. Now. Sometimes I believe. And I want to touch on these points.

Because they affect me. Sometimes we may feel this. That God the Father. So. Awful in majesty.

So remote. So far distant. So unapproachable. Can never surely. Receive. Any acknowledgement from us.

[ 12 : 10 ] And. Can only. Look upon us. With displeasure. But when we come to a word like this.

If this is the right interpretation of it. It seems to put all that on one side. And we see. That equally with the dear son of God.

The Father. Is. In. Unison. Of purpose. His heart likewise. Is full of love.

To his people. He rejoices. In the salvation. Because. That salvation. Is to release. Sinners.

From the bonds. Of corruption. And death. It's a salvation. That will lift the beggar. Out of the dunhill. It's a salvation.

[ 13 : 06 ] That is not for time. But for eternity. And it's a salvation. That is free. There are.

No merits. To obtain it. No requirements. From the creature. The recipient. To lay hold upon it.

It is free. It is free. And it is sovereign. It is rich. With all the wonders of God.

It is full. Of all the fullness of God. God. And therefore. It is the highest. Favor God. God can bestow.

And in the bestowing of it. God says. We. Will rejoice. God. I feel. It's a precious truth.

[ 14 : 06 ] To realize. My friends. That. God the Father. Is one. With his own dear son. In the bestowing. Of the favors.

The blessings. And the mercies. That we so greatly need. So then. The first thing.

We have. In our text. Looking at it. In this light. Is a very precious one. We will. Rejoice. In thy salvation. And I said. At the beginning.

It's the testimony. Of the Trinity. We will. Rejoice. You know. In the beginning. Of the creation.

You read. A very striking word. It's often overlooked. But it's one of the most. Important truths.

[ 15 : 01 ] That we should always hold. Very dearly. And that is this. When God. Had made the world. Brought it into being.

Formed it. In accordance. With his mighty. And wonderful power. There came the time. When he was to make man. And this is what.

God. Almighty says. Let us. Make man. In our image. I remember.

Some little time ago. Two young men. Called at my house. And they called themselves. Jehovah's Witnesses. And they approached me.

In this way. They said. Do you. Believe in the Trinity. I said. Yes. I most certainly do. So they smiled at me. Very. Patronizingly.

[ 15 : 58 ] And they gave me a Bible. And they said. Would I. Look through this Bible. And tell. Them. Where the word. Trinity. Occurred. I said. I couldn't. Because it doesn't occur.

But I can tell you. Where the Trinity. Occurred. Very clearly. And again. Thinking that they would. Confound me.

They asked me to do so. And I turned to the 36th verse. Of the first chapter. Of Genesis. And I made them read it. Three times.

Let us. Make man. In our image. And after they had read it. Three times. I asked them this question.

Who is God speaking to? For there were neither. Men. Nor angels. Let us.

[ 16 : 53 ] Make man. There is the Trinity. My friends. In the very beginning. Of the word of God. And that Trinity.

Is in unity. In unity. Of purpose. All the plans. Of God. Are plans. Of a. Triune.

You. You. Jehovah. There is no. Division. Whatsoever. Between the Father. And the Son. And the Holy Ghost.

They are all. Combined. In the. Salvation. Of God's. Church. And people. And therefore. My text. Is a very.

Precious text. Looking at it. In this life. We. We. We. Will rejoice. In thy salvation. Then. And in the name.

[ 17 : 49 ] Of our God. We will set up. Our banners. What does this mean? Then. Looking at it. In that. Same light. I believe.

It means this. God's. Declaration. That he will set up. Before the eyes of men.

That which will never be. Removed. Or destroyed. Under which. His own people.

Will come. Blessedly. And gloriously. To fall down. And to be united. With him.

And that is. The banner. Of the gospel. God must set it up. We cannot set it up. Not in this. Prime. Sense.

[ 18 : 44 ] That our. Text. Brings. Before us. But. In. The name. Of our God. We will set up. Our banners.

And oh. What a glorious. Banner. That is. The banner. Of the gospel. What a. Uniting. Instrument.

It is. For. Poor. And rich. We read. In the book. Of Proverbs. Are made one. Rich. And poor.

Meet together. Souls. That are very. Distance. Distant. From one another. In all. Manner. Of.

Ways. In experience. In the depths. Into which. They may. Have gone. Into the things. Of this world. And sin.

[ 19 : 39 ] When they come. Under the banner. Of the gospel. They're all. Made one. They're all. Brought. By that banner. To one level. When the gospel.

Is preached. It will bring. Hearers. If it has. Any effect. Upon those. Hearers. It will bring them. To that level. That all. Plain. Level. Common level.

Where they are. Needy. Sinners. Helpless. In themselves. And. Needing. The salvation. Of the Lord. And oh.

What a glorious. Banner. That is. The banner. Of the gospel. Have we ever. Been brought. Under it. When the.

Ancient. People. Went forth. To battle. They had. Banners. They were rallying. Coins. They were of great.

[ 20 : 35 ] Value. To the armies. Because. While the banner. Was. Lifted high. There was courage. Imparted.
